ASHTON AND PARSONS INFANT POWDERS

COMPOSITION

Each individually wrapped powder contains 4,055 mg Tincture Matricaria Duplex

Excipients:

Lactose monohydrate, magnesium stearate

Contains sugar: Lactose monohydrate 259,62 mg

CATEGORY AND CLASS

A 11 Medicines acting on gastrointestinal tract

PHARMACOLOGICAL ACTION

Pharmacodynamic properties

The Tincture Matricaria relieves the symptoms of mild stomach upsets and mild indigestion associated with teething.

INDICATIONS

For children teething and for slight stomach ailments occurring in infancy.

CONTRAINDICATIONS

Not to be given to a baby known to be intolerant to lactose. This is a rare condition (see WARNINGS AND SPECIAL PRECAUTIONS).

WARNINGS AND SPECIAL PRECAUTIONS

Not known.

Excipients

ASHTON AND PARSONS INFANT POWDERS contains lactose which may have an effect on the glycaemic control of patients with diabetes mellitus.

Patients with the rare hereditary conditions of galactose intolerance e.g. galactosaemia, Lapp lactase deficiency, glucose-galactose malabsorption or fructose intolerance should not take ASHTON AND PARSONS INFANT POWDERS.

HUMAN REPRODUCTION

DOSAGE AND DIRECTIONS FOR USE

One powder to be given dry on the tongue, night and morning.

When the child is very restless, fretful or feverish, the dose can be repeated every one, two or three hours if necessary until the condition is improved.

SIDE EFFECTS

Not known.

KNOWN SYMPTOMS OF OVERDOSAGE AND PARTICULARS OF ITS TREATMENTS

No risk of overdosage.

IDENTIFICATION

A fine white crystalline powder free from visible foreign matter.

PRESENTATION

1 individually wrapped powder is folded in printed wrapper paper.

20 Powders are packed in a cardboard carton with a leaflet.

STORAGE INSTRUCTIONS

Store at or below 25 °C in a dry place.

Keep in original packaging until required for use.
